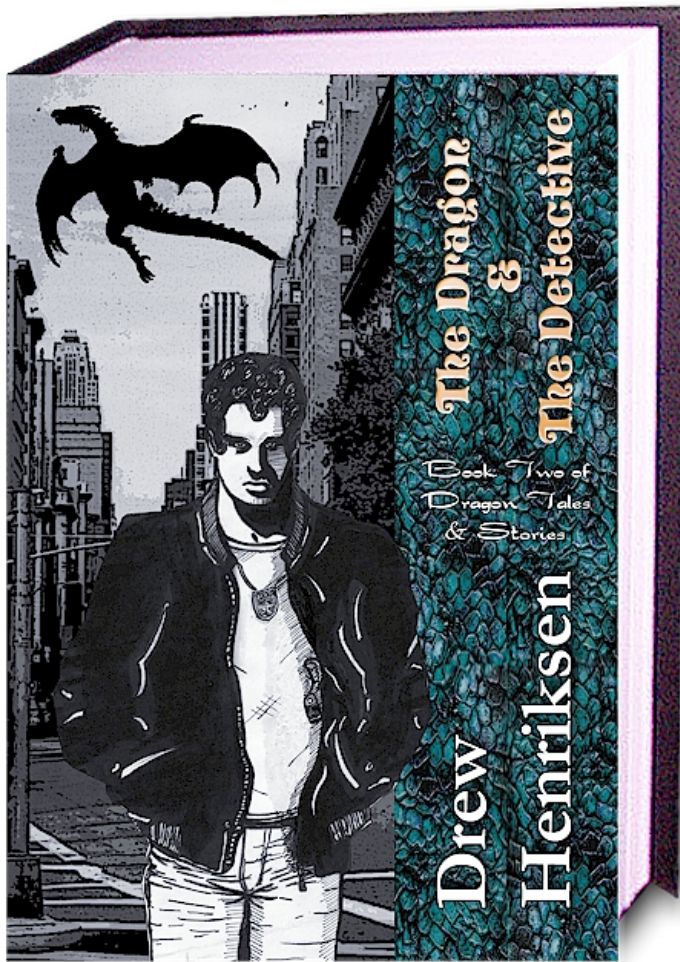


The Dragon & The Detective by Drew Henriksen
