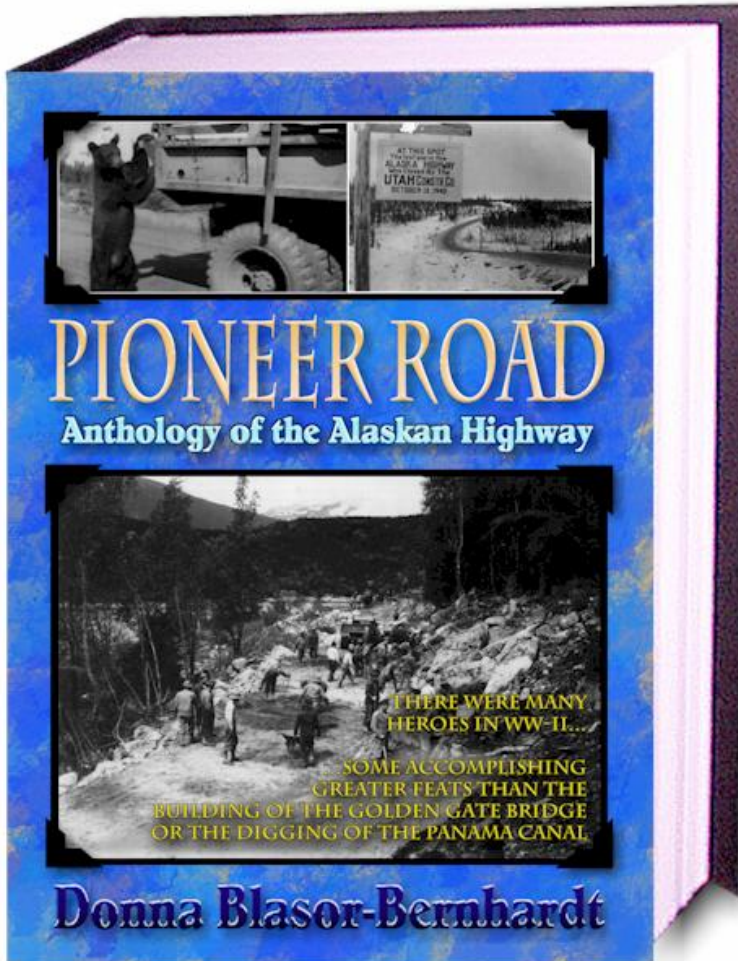


PIONEER ROAD
